We object to RIEL's "request" to separate the proceedings in to two motions. RICL is telling you how the land owners Feel. A's landowners, we did not give them the authority to speak for us. turthermore, the voluntary easements signed are still at less than 15 %. That tells me that the people, the landowners have spoken. 8500 are saying no to this project and no to the use of eminent domain. RICL's "request" does not read like a "request". It reads more like an order from a higher up telling the IUB -"This is what we expect from you We do not believe that among the 85 % who have not signed an easement - that many will just sign with your decision to allow this - that they are just waiting for your go ahead. I have also heard that some among the 1500 who have signed did so due to Fear of eminent domain. They were told that they might as well sign.
