Please let this correspondence serve as the Preservation of Rural Iowa Alliance's ("PRIA") comments to the proposals discussed at the conference on July 11, 2016.

The PRIA rejects the proposal suggested by Rock Island Clean Line in its entirety. The PRIA supports the proposal suggested by the Iowa Utilities Board with the following addition and/or comments. The proposal seems to be missing what was our understanding was addressed or proposed at the hearing: an inclusion of requiring Rock Island Clean Line to submit additional counties until all Exhibit E's were submitted. PRIA suggests that additional Exhibit E's be submitted in a timely manner in order to make the timeline and deadline requirements work. The drafts that were displayed on the screen at the conference had Rock Island Clean Line submitting two more counties each month until all Exhibit E's were submitted. PRIA agrees that additional Exhibit E's should be submitted; however, instead of two each additional month, it should be four.

PRIA would also request deadlines for designation of experts, with expert reports, and request a discovery cutoff deadline.
