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**ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF PRELIMINARY  
IMPLEMENTATION PLANS**

(Issued December 2, 2016)

On August 31, 2016, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a motion to withdraw its preliminary implementation plans that were filed on March 28, 2016, in response to the Board's October 30, 2015, "Order Regarding Policy Statement, Rate Design Presentations, and Net-Metering Generation Pilots."

IPL states that it filed three preliminary implementation plans in response to the October 30, 2015, order which it now seeks to withdraw: "Residential and General Service Customer-Owned Renewables Rate Design Pilot," "Large General Service Customer-Owned Renewables Rate Design Pilot," and "Community Solar Pilot." IPL states that in response to the Board's order on July 19, 2016, "Directing Filing of Net Metering Tariffs," IPL filed its proposed three-year net-metering pilot tariff as TF-2016-0321, which renders the preliminary implementation plans moot. IPL also asks that the Board consider closing Docket No. NOI-2014-0001.

The Board has considered IPL's motion and finds that it is reasonable. Since the new net-metering pilot tariff replaces the previously-filed preliminary implementation plan, the Board will approve IPL's request to withdraw the plans. However, the Board will not close Docket No. NOI-2014-0001 at this time as comments continue to be filed in this docket.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The "Motion to Withdraw Preliminary Implementation Plans" filed by Interstate Power and Light Company on August 31, 2016, is granted.
