The Prison Policy Initiative, Inc. ("<u>PPI</u>") joins in the comments filed in the above-captioned proceeding on January 19, 2021 by the Office of the Consumer Advocate ("<u>OCA</u>"). Specifically, PPI strongly agrees with the OCA's comments regarding the inappropriate payment-fee provisions in Reliance Telephone's proposed revised tariff. Federal rules concerning ancillary fees were implemented to address well-documented abuses in the inmate calling services industry. Reliance's proposal to charge a \$3 automated payment fee *plus* pass-through card-processing costs to customers constitutes double-dipping that violates the letter and spirit of 47 C.F.R. § 64.6020.

For the reasons stated in OCA's comments, PPI encourages the Board to require additional revisions to the ancillary-fee provisions of Reliance's proposed tariff before granting approval.
