**ORDER ACCEPTING REVISED TARIFF AND DETERMINING REQUEST FOR
ADDITIONAL TIME MOOT**

On December 11, 2020, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an Order Requiring Revisions to Revised Tariff that directed Prodigy Solutions, Inc. (Prodigy), to file revisions to its revised tariff within 30 days, which was January 11, 2021.

On January 12, 2021, Prodigy filed with the Board a request for extension of time to file a response to the order. Prodigy requests an extension of 60 days to file its revisions.

On January 13, 2021, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), a division of the Iowa Department of Justice, filed a partial resistance to Prodigy's request for additional time. In the partial resistance, OCA states that an extension of 60 days is not warranted and requests that a shorter deadline be granted.

On January 21, 2021, Prodigy filed with the Board its revised tariff, as required by the Board's December 11, 2020 order.

This docket is one of eight inmate calling service provider dockets currently before the Board. The Board is interested in resolving these matters expeditiously to allow customers to utilize inmate calling services at just and reasonable rates. The
