RE: Docket No. SPU-2021-0015 - Review Requested for Revised Map

Dear Mr. Cardon and Ms. Mommsen:

On February 7, 2022, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) and Preston Municipal Utilities (PMU), filed a Joint Response (Response) to Iowa Utilities Board (IUB) staff's January 24, 2022 letter and revised map. The IUB staff letter requested IPL and PMU to confirm that the revised map attached to that letter accurately reflected the modifications discussed at the January 21, 2022 video conference call with IUB staff, IPL, PMU, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), a division of the Iowa Department of Justice, and the Office of the Chief Information Officer.

IPL and PMU's February 7, 2022 Response stated, "the map attached to the correspondence accurately depicts how their respective service territory boundary lines should exist following the resolution of this proceeding, with regard to the geographic area depicted on that map." IPL and PMU also stated that the map omitted a parcel of land east of the City of Preston that IPL is currently serving in PMU's service territory. According to the Response, PMU is transferring that parcel to IPL and identified the parcel in Exhibit 3A and Exhibit 3B of the November 22, 2022 Joint Petition for Adjustment of Service Territory (Petition).

Attached is a "final" map of the proposed modifications, which includes the proposed modifications listed in the Petition, discussed at the January 21, 2022 video conference call, and in IPL's and PMU's February 7, 2022 Response. IUB staff requests that IPL,

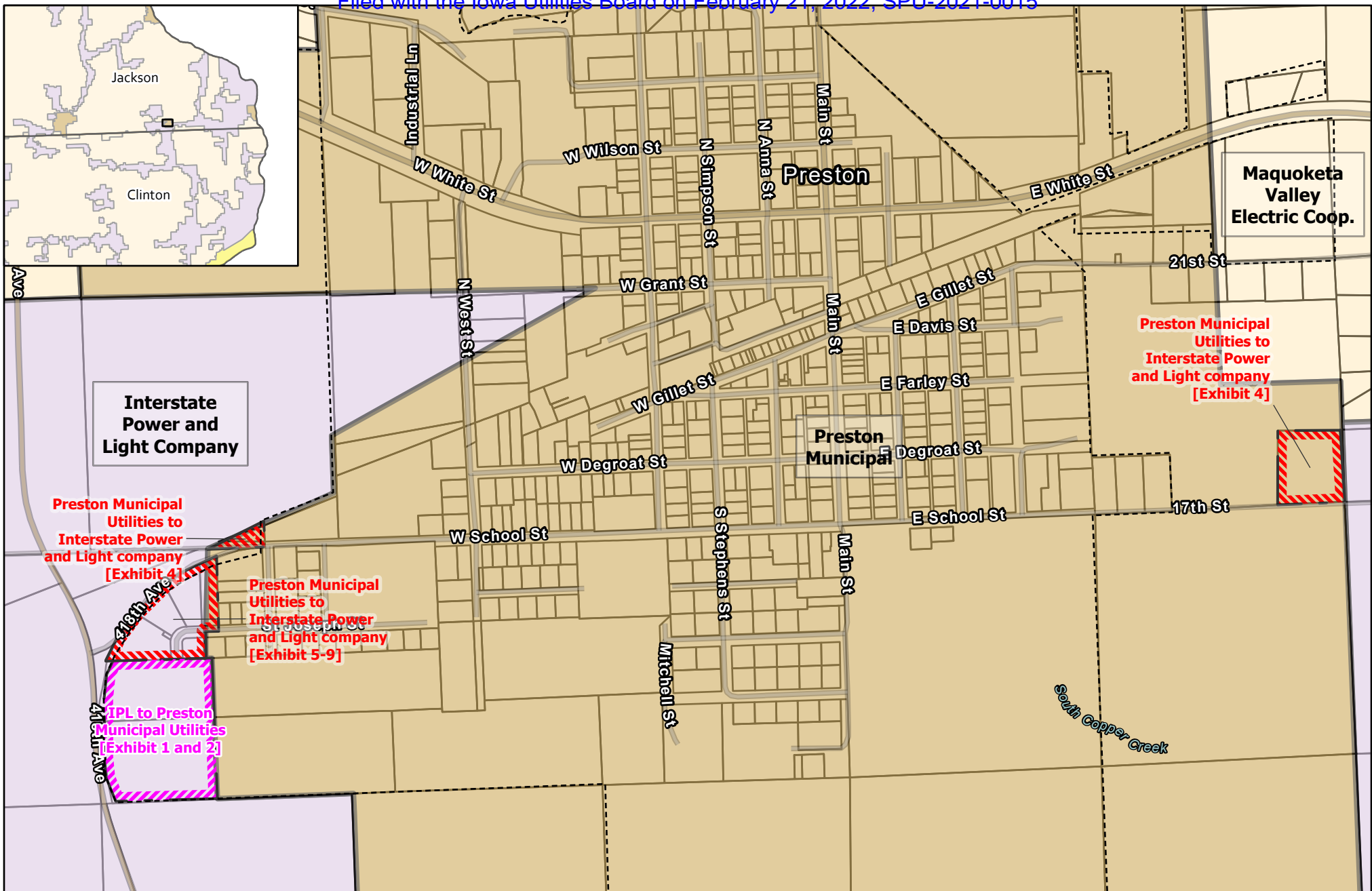

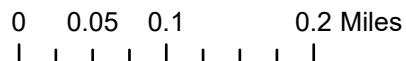
