**JOINT RESPONSE TO REVISED MAP**

Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) and Preston Municipal Utilities (PMU) hereby submit this joint response to the Staff Correspondence of Ms. Trisha Quijano, Utility Analyst, of the Iowa Utilities (Board) Regulatory analysis section, filed in the above-referenced docket on February 21, 2022 (Staff Correspondence).

The Staff Correspondence requested that:

IPL, PMU, and OCA review the attached map and file a response within five days that states whether the attached map is accurate and in “final” form.

**RESPONSE:**

With regard to the parcel that IPL is currently serving in PMU’s service territory east of the City of Preston, which PMU is transferring to IPL, IPL and PMU respond that the map attached to the correspondence does not accurately reflect how their respective service territory boundary lines should exist following the resolution of this proceeding.

The address for this parcel is 44180 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Preston, and is identified in Exhibit 3A and Exhibit 3B of the Joint Petition for Adjustment of Service. As depicted on the map attached (Attachment A) to this Joint Response, the western

IPL parcel line should align with the existing service boundary line between PMU and Maquoketa Valley Electric Cooperative (MVEC) to the north of the parcel, and the service boundary line between IPL and PMU to the south should align with the western side of the parcel as shown on the map attached to the Staff Correspondence.

IPL and PMU thank Board Staff and Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) Staff for their continued efforts on this issue. IPL and PMU staff would be happy to arrange a conference call with Board Staff and OCIO staff to discuss these boundary lines in further detail, if desired.

IPL and PMU have conferred with the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) about the Joint Response and OCA has no objection.


