I am a co-owner of a Century Farm in Shelby County, Iowa that is in the path of the proposed Summit Carbon pipeline.

I am opposed to this project for many reasons but on this occasion, I want to briefly address the plans for Safety regarding a compressed hazardous liquid running through pipelines on our farm.

I want to know what education Summit has given to all communities impacted? Since we have been told in local community meetings, that they have already ordered their pipe for this project, then I would assume they have already provided training and education seminars to all affected communities? Is that true, and if so, can you please advise where and when this training was done? Or, as I suspect, are they under the assumption that all emergency response teams- paid and volunteer already know everything they need to know to respond to a Hazardous compressed Co2 leak and or explosion?

For instance, say that there is a spill, leak or even an explosion at the site of our farm property in this fairly remote section of country. There are rural water lines on our property, there is a hog confinement near our property that belongs to a neighbor, there is a farmstead/home nearby. How will this be detected? Who is going to notify the people living nearby?

Who is going to remove the hogs in the confinement to a safer place? Who is going to notify the folks who drink water from the rural water line that it is or may not be safe to use? What is the anticipated timeline for all the emergency personnel arriving? Depending on the wind direction- how close will anyone be able to get to the disaster? Have routes for upwind, uphill been established by emergency response personnel to avoid being in the vapor cloud of the poisonous gas release? Does the emergency response team have appropriate air monitoring equipment to establish the extent of vapor travel? Does the emergency response team have Hazmat suits and equipment for their safety. How close will they be able to park to the disaster since vehicle engines are potential ignition sources? Or is Summit going to provide all Fire departments with electric vehicles to approach the sceneand is this even safe with the batteries that electric vehicles use? Who is going to evacuate those closely to a safe area? What will be the isolation zone set up?

The logistics alone in responding to this type of disaster are mind boggling. Can you imagine how this one beginning of a disaster scenario is not even close to taking into account all that will need to be done to mitigate the disaster?

Please consider that given what we have heard thus far from Summit's plans, I am not convinced that they have a real plan to mitigate any disasters that their pipeline could cause.

Please note that I am opposing this project and request you do not approve the permit.



Dear Iowa Utilities Board,

This is my 4th letter to you objecting to the proposed hazardous CO2 pipelines. In previous letters I noted the concerns of local landowners like myself, of impact on public properties like the Charles City Area Development site within the city limits and county infrastructure, and safety concerns.

I also noted that POET, the largest ethanol producer, has other strategies to reduce and utilize their CO2 emissions and is not involved in the pipelines. If Summit, Navigator and ADM Wolf employed Poet's methods, the temporary and permanent damage caused by pipeline construction on private and public properties as well as the liability and safety issues would be avoided.

The Iowa Legislature has had 3 bills introduced to limit eminent domain to public good, not corporate profit. None got out of committee for full debate. A bill to postpone the use of eminent domain till February, 2023, is unlikely to become law before the Legislature adjourns. Based on conversations I've had with Summit's land agents, survey crew members and construction staff, they assume the Iowa Utilities Board will impose eminent domain and that construction will begin in the spring of 2023.

Summit Carbon Solutions (SCS) submitted their request for eminent domain to you in January, 2022, without the required Schedule H showing the route and landowners affected. They have this information and are scrambling to increase the number/ percentage of landowners who have signed easement agreements voluntarily. The Navigator and ADM Wolf pipelines have already begun holding the required public meetings, are doing route surveys, and contacting landowners with easement agreements. If SCS is granted eminent domain, others will follow. The damage to private and public properties and concerns for public safety will increase. Floyd and Hardin County are among several counties hosting more than one of the proposed pipelines compounding the damage and safety concerns.

Iowa Public Television is broadcasting a series of Frontline programs on "The Power of Big Oil". The first program can be viewed at this link (https://www.pbs.org/video/the-power-of-big-oil-part-one-denial-redxh6/). Starting in the 1980s, oil company and independent researchers noted climate change and the link to fossil fuels. The show includes Congressional testimony from 1988 on the greenhouse effects and failed efforts to pass a BTU tax. Al Gore and representatives of Congress, major oil companies, the American Petroleum Institute, the Global Climate Coalition, Koch Industries and their CATO Institute, and a PR firm hired by the fossil fuels industry are interviewed. They describe coordinated efforts to raise doubts about climate change and the link to human activities and to influence public policy to their advantage. The impact of fossil fuels on local economies is stressed. Part II of this program was shown on PBS/IPT at 9 PM on Tuesday, April 26th. All ;programs in the series can probably be viewed at the PBS website as well.

The CO2 pipeline companies are following the same playbook and many of the oil companies are \$upportive and involved in the pipeline permitting, construction and operation. Rising oil prices are being used to promote drilling on public lands and influence public opinion on related issues. Big Oil is enjoying record profits.

This ad below, paid by the Center for International Environmental Law, was published in the Washington Post. It summarizes many of the reasons why these pipelines are not the answer to our climate and environmental issues.

It's Time to End Carbon Capture of Climate Policy - An Open Letter to US and Canadian Leaders

On behalf of our millions of members and supporters across the United States and Canada, we call on policymakers to recognize that carbon capture and storage (CCS) is not a climate solution. It is a dangerous distraction driven by the same big polluters who created the climate emergency.

CCS is unnecessary. Renewable energy sources like solar and wind are cheaper and cleaner than fossil fuels. CCS just makes dirty energy more expensive and more energy-intensive.

CCS does not work. CCS projects have systematically overpromised and underdelivered. Despite the billions of taxpayer dollars wasted on CCS to date, the technology has not made a dent in CO2 emissions.

CCS will do little to reduce industrial emissions. Deploying CCS at scale is not economically viable for most heavy-emitting industries, such as plastic or chemical manufacturing. It diverts resources from available and scalable alternatives such as replacing fossil fuels with clean renewable energy sources to supply power and heat, and reusing inputs to reduce the production of virgin material.

CCS makes dirty energy even more dangerous for frontline communities. Facilities equipped with carbon capture technology have to burn more fossil fuel to get the same energy output, resulting in increased emissions of toxic and hazardous pollutants, like fine particulates (PM2.5).

CCS imposes even more risks on communities from CO2 pipelines and storage. Transporting, injecting, and storing CO2 presents new environmental, health, and safety hazards in communities targeted for CCS infrastructure. Pipelines can leak or rupture, and injection can contaminate water sources. These risks fall disproportionately on Black, Brown, Indigenous, and low-income communities, further entrenching a bleak history of environmental racism.

Most CCS benefits polluters. Nearly 80% of captured carbon is used to pump more oil out of the ground through "enhanced oil recovery." Polluting industries are using the myth of CCS to justify business-as-usual operations that are dangerous for the climate and communities.

Pumping even more public funds into new CCS subsidies for fossil fuel and petrochemical industries will just prop up unsustainable business models.

We don't need to fix fossil fuels; we need to ditch them. Instead of capturing carbon to pump it back underground, we should keep fossil fuels in the ground in the first place. And instead of bankrolling CCS, public funds should be boosting sustainable, job-creating solutions to the climate crisis, for fossil-dependent workers and communities: phasing out oil, gas, and coal; investing in energy efficiency and non-combustion renewable energy sources; and protecting forests and other ecosystems that naturally capture and store carbon.

These pipeline projects are counting on public funds (Federal carbon credits and tax credits) to construct, operate, and maintain the pipeline and provide investor profits. Property taxes will also be required to cover on —going local infrastructure maintenance and repair costs. Who owns? Who controls? And Who benefits? Follow the money. NO EMINENT DOMAIN FOR CORPORATE GAIN!
