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**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO FILING BY ISG**

On April 20, 2022, Evan Del Val of ISG filed a memorandum in the above-referenced docket titled “Proposed Revisions to the Iowa Utilities Board’s Instructions for County Inspectors manual and 199 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 9 (199 IAC 9.5) Construction in Wet Conditions” (the “ISG Filing”). The ISG Filing suggests that the Board adopt certain revisions to the Instructions for County Inspectors and Chapter 9 of the Board’s Rules regarding construction during “wet conditions.”

While the ISG Filing is not identified as a motion, to the extent that the filing could be treated as a motion, a response to it would be due on May 4, 2022 under Board Rule 7.12. In order to allow Summit Carbon Solutions, LLC (“Summit Carbon”) adequate time to confer with its retained soils experts and prepare a response to the ISG Filing, Summit Carbon respectfully requests an extension of two weeks, to and including May 18, 2022, to file a response to the ISG Filing.
