

STATEMENT OF DAN TRONCHETTI

My name is Dan Tronchetti and I am a landowner in Greene County who will be impacted by the Summit carbon dioxide pipeline if it is constructed. I don't want the pipeline on my property and I will not sign an easement.

On November 22, 2021, I had my first contact with a Summit land agent named Kent Parker. He wanted me to sign an easement, and I emphatically told him I would not sign an easement. Then, over a 10-day period starting on April 11, 2022, I received four messages from a land agent named Jack Scanlon, who identified himself as a Summit land agent. In his second message he stated that my neighbor, Corrin Smith, told him to call me. However, Ms. Smith has indicated that she did not tell Mr. Scanlon to call me and didn't know what he was talking about. I am aware that one of the tactics used by land agents is to use a landowner's family, friends or neighbors to influence the landowner to sign an easement.

After that April 11 call I received a voice mail from a land agent. I did not return the call. So the agent called again, asked for a call back, and he said "I guess I'll have to drive out to your house." I did not respond and the land agent called again and, sounding frustrated, asked for a call back.

I have made it clear that I will not sign an easement, and I just want the land agents to stop harassing me.
