Eminent domain is a threat to democracy when private investors propose a project that is NOT NEEDED, is DESTRUCTIVE, and more importantly is NOT WANTED BY THE PUBLIC. Nine hundred eminent domain easements are needed. Summit's destructive pipeline would dictate and restrict what can be done in Iowa well into the

future.

Eminent domain should not be used for a PRIVATE, TEMPORARY GRAB AND SELL PIPELINE. Summit plans to just sell and walk away. Property owners must maintain the property, with restricted building and heavy equipment. When sold, a new hazardous chemical and plume will be placed in the nearby, ageing pipeline. Food and Water Watch says the major busts in Carbon Capture projects make them appear to be a handout to fossil fuel corporations, publicly financing their attempts to keep their harmful product viable. If it weren't for greed, the destructive, temporary, 45Q proposal wouldn't exist. C02 pipelines are dangerous, outdated, and ineffective.

The only way Summit's C02 pipeline is for the public is THE PUBLIC PAYS FOR EVERYTHING. The dangerous C02 pipeline is only for private profit. A CLEAR DEFINITION OF EMINENT DOMAIN SHOULD BE ON THE BALLOT THIS FALL. That would protect and restore justice, freedoms, and property rights so people in Iowa could live in safety.

BETTER ONSITE CAPTURE is ignored because it doesn't put money in private investors' pockets. C02 is currently captured at ethanol plants, sold, and transported. The monies are kept in state. C02 can even be Converted to C0 which is used for methanol and ethanol.

C02 is sold to euthanize animals. THE PEOPLE WILL PAY with their lives if there is a predicted leak from Summit's extremely long pipeline. PLUME INFORMATION IS NOT MADE PUBLIC FOR A REASON.

With the public monies, private investors get free C02 and free transportation to oil sites. THE PUBLIC PAYS. Large amounts of water are needed. THE PUBLIC PAYS WITH THEIR LIMITED RESOURCES. Private property is damaged, permanently destroyed, kept, and sold. THE PUBLIC PAYS.
