<sup>2</sup> On March 13, 2020, the Iowa Utilities Board (Board) extended the winter moratorium until May 1, 2020. On March 18, 2020, IPL announced a temporary suspension of disconnections for all Iowa customers during the public health emergency related to the COVID-19 outbreak, and no involuntary disconnections have occurred since IPL's announcement. On March 27, 2020, the Iowa Utilities Board issued an order in Docket NO. SPU-2020-0003 restricting all electric and natural gas utilities from disconnecting any customers until the public health emergency is lifted by written statement of the Governor.
